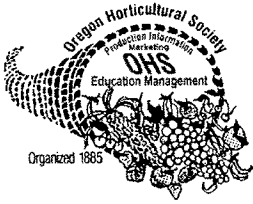

IF YOU HAVE NOT PAID YOUR 2010 OHS MEMBERSHIP DUES:

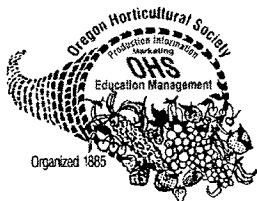
- If you are not planning to attend the 2010 annual meeting and want to join OHS, send only the dues form with payment to the OHS office.
